Send an email to [\\$listname-request@openindiana.org](mailto:$listname-request@openindiana.org) e.g [openindiana-discuss-request@openindiana.org](mailto:openindiana-discuss-request@openindiana.org) with the word **subscribe** in the *body* of the email.

You will be sent an email, asking you to confirm your subscription. This can be done via clicking a link or responding to the email.
